GRANDMA EV'S CARMEL ROLLS EASY PEASY

THIS CLASSIC & SIMPLE ROCKY POINT FAVORITE WAS EVELYN ARNESEN'S RECIPE FOR CARMEL ROLLS. SHE WOULD MAKE THEM EVERY MORNING FOR THE OLD STORE AT ROCKY POINT. ENJOY!

INGREDIENTS

12 frozen cinnamon rolls

Brown sugar

Heavy whipping cream

(Ev's original recipe called for Coffee Rich, but it's very hard to find!)

DIRECTIONS

Place enough brown sugar to cover the bottom of a 9x13 pan (*the more sugar you use, the gooier it will be*). Add whipping cream to make the brown sugar "sloppy". Place frozen rolls on top of brown sugar/whipping cream mixture. Cover with a muslin dish towel and let rise overnight. Bake at 350° for 25-30 minutes. Let the rolls cool for 5 minutes in pan before flipping over onto a serving platter. Serve warm.

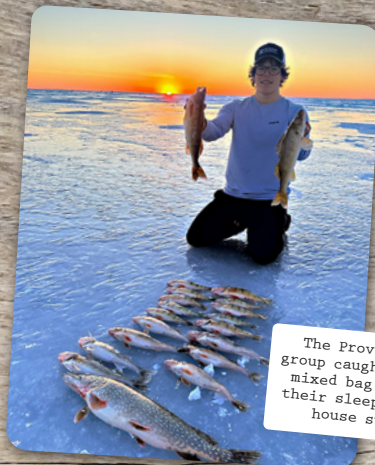

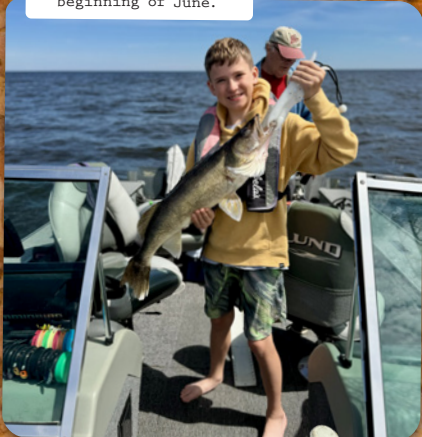

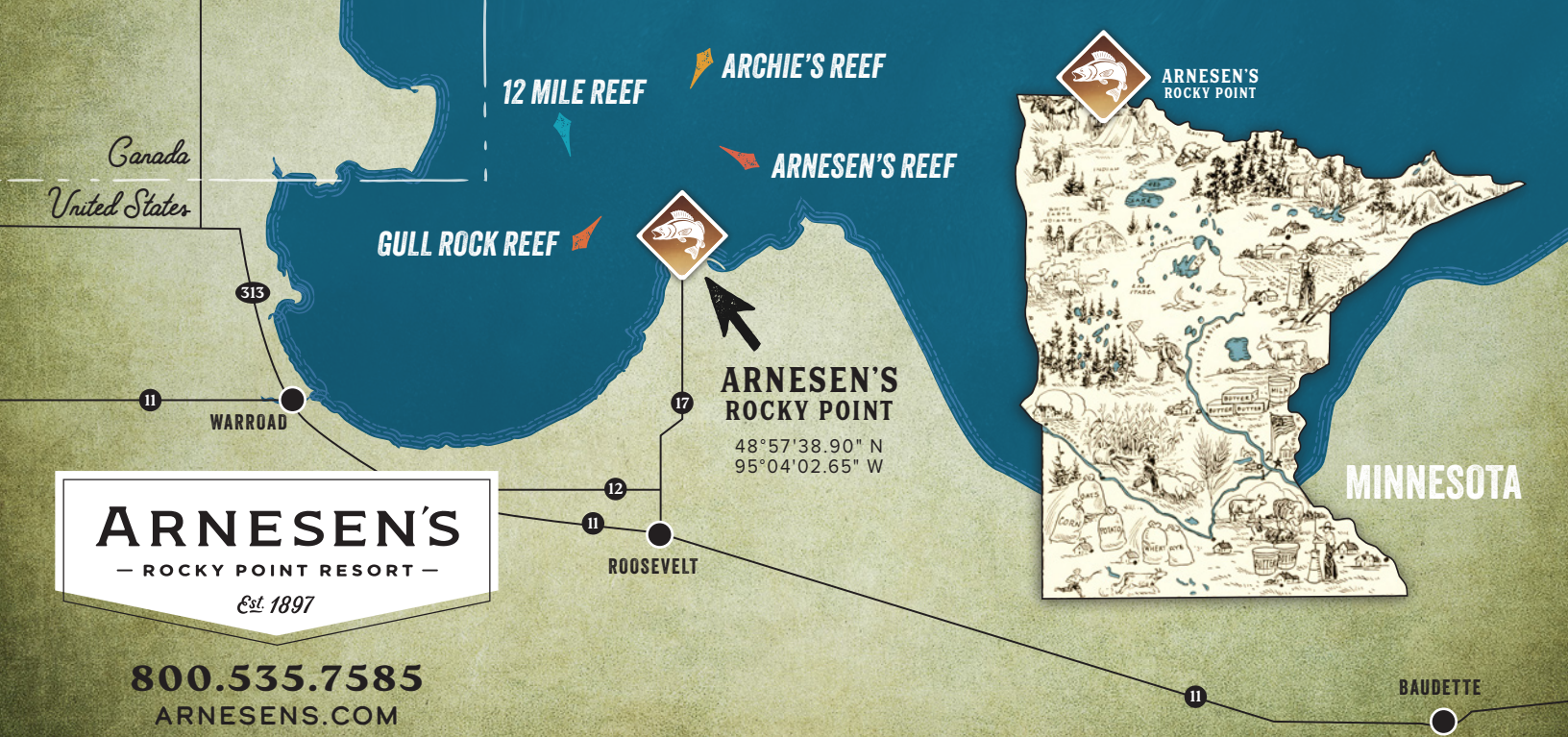
PET POLICY
